Annual Implementation Plan

Strategic Goal 1: Student Engagement and Achievement

Every student is engaged in their learning in a manner that challenges them to reach meaningful personal goals and maintains high academic standards.

Objective 1: Track and report on junior (Year 9 and Year 10) students' academic potential, progress, and engagement.

Goals/Targets:

- Establish achievement levels of all Year 9 & 10 students using assessment tools.
- All Year 9 and 10 students increase their Curriculum Sub-level by 2 sub-levels by the end of the year.
- Tracking data shared regularly with staff to enable appropriate interventions.

Objective 2: Track and report on engagement and achievement of Years 11–13 students against departmental NZQA (NCEA and Scholarship) targets.

Goals/Targets:

- 100% of Year 11 students gain Level 1 Literacy and Numeracy.
- 100% of eligible students gain University Entrance (UE).
- 50% of students gain a Merit or Excellence endorsement at all NCEA levels.
- 50% of Scholarship subject entries achieve Scholarship.

Objective 3: Identify and report on the achievement of targeted student groups.

Targeted Groups:

Māori and Pasifika students

Students with Specific Learning Needs

Gifted and Talented students

International students

Goals/Targets:

- Identified M\u00e4ori and Pasifika students achieve specified curriculum and NCEA progress.
- Identified students with Specific Learning Needs achieve specified curriculum and NCEA progress.
- Gifted and Talented students are provided with appropriate extension programmes.
- ESOL programme enhances the academic performance of International Students.

Strategic Goal 2: Staff Development

Employ highly qualified staff and promote engagement in ongoing professional learning.

Objective 1: Develop staff engagement in their Professional Growth Cycle (Teachers) or Appraisal Cycle (Support Staff).

Goals/Targets:

- All staff complete an Annual Summary Statement or Appraisal Summary.
